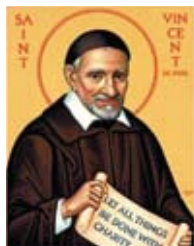




## RECOGNIZING SERVICE SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL SERVICE AWARD



### ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The de Paul Service award is a \$1,000 scholarship given annually by the USM Office of Campus Ministry to incoming students who demonstrate active and consistent participation in youth ministry activities and who wish to further develop their Christian leadership through service and ministry.

If you're interested, you should apply to USM's campus ministry. Your application will be evaluated based on several criteria.

- You must have demonstrated consistent Christian leadership through community service, Christian ministry, and activity in the tradition of Saint Vincent de Paul. (A written recommendation from a pastor, youth minister, or other leader is required.)
- A 250-word essay describing the value and importance of Christian ministry and community service and your future related goals.
- A 3.0 GPA or equivalent in high school or a 2.5 transfer GPA.

If you are selected for the award, as a recipient you must:

- Act as a representative for the campus ministry to the student body.
- Participate in campus ministry activities including liturgy, retreats, outreach, and service trips.
- Participate in planning at least two campus ministry activities during the year.
- Present one campus ministry service experience to the USM community per year.
- Satisfactorily maintain a fulltime (12 hours per semester) academic schedule with a 3.0 or higher GPA each academic year at USM.
