### Sample Three Year Plan for a Biomedical Sciences Major for students entering USM with a Composite ACT score of 28 and above

Note: students should consult the Biology Program faculty early on in their education so that a plan can be specifically tailored for the student.

This will allow the Biology Program faculty to take account of:

- any AP courses, dual credit or college credit courses taken already which will allow certain courses in the sample plan to be omitted

It should be noted that many science courses have pre-requisites. Additionally, some are taught only every two years.

A student's individual interests can be catered for with specific elective courses, and such interests are best discussed with the Biology Program faculty.

It is the desire of the Biology Program faculty to allow the student to complete all requirements for the major in 3 years, whilst also avoiding overload charges (the maximum number of credit hours allowed per semester is 18). Depending on the course history of the student prior to beginning their studies at USM, this may not always be possible. In such cases, the Biology Program faculty will suggest best options for the student, perhaps taking some courses over the summers.
