Additional Requirements for Major

*In addition to the university general education requirements, the elementary education majors fulfill the following:

PY 290 Psychology of Childhood and Adolescence is a required course for education majors

At least two history courses, including one US history

A biology and a physical science course with at least one lab in natural science

Formal admission to the Teacher Education Program

The PPST is required prior to enrolling in education courses. Required scores (R-173, W-172, M-172) must be achieved for formal admission to the Teacher Education Program.

Required application materials for admission should be submitted by September 1 of the Junior Year.
