Ninety-three Full-time Undergraduates Named to Honor's List

101 Total Students Post 3.5 GPA or better for Fall Semester

(Leavenworth, Kan.)— At the close of each semester, it is with great pleasure that the University of Saint Mary recognize the outstanding academic achievements of its students. Continuing the university's 80 year tradition of greatness, this past fall academic semester witnessed a total of 101 undergraduate students, 93 full-time, named to the Fall 2004 Honor's List for maintaining a 3.5 or better grade point average on a 4.0 scale.

According to Dr. Sandra VanHoose, Vice President and Dean of Academic Affairs, being named to the Honor's List is a distinction students should always strive to achieve.
