Both the Goldenbergs have dedicated their lives to music. An accomplished pianist, Bill Goldenberg is Chair of the Piano Department at Northern Illinois University. He has performed with the Vermeer Quartet and with principal artists of the London and Boston Symphonies. He has served as an adjudicator at the Liszt Academy in Budapest and at the Shanghai Conservatory of Music.

His sister, Susan, has been in the first violin section of the National Symphony of Costa Rica, the Charlotte Symphony and has played for 25 years with the Kansas City Symphony.
