Both Daniels, a soprano and Harris, a tenor, have spent the past four-years working under the tutelage of USM Fine Arts—Music Chairperson and Professor, Dr. William Krusemark. Daniels is a senior theatre major from Kansas City, Mo. and Harris is a senior music and Spanish major from Kansas City, Kan. Both students are presenting this recital in partial fulfillment of the requirements for the applied music minor in Vocal Performance.

Daniels' program will include songs and arias in Italian, French, and German as well as several selections from the Broadway repertoire including "Can't Help Lovin' That Man" from "*Showboat*." Harris' program will include six lieder in German from Schumann's "*Dichterliebe*" song cycle as well as arias and songs in Italian, Spanish, French and English. Daniels and Harris will also perform duets from "*The Mikado*" and "*The Phantom of the Opera*." Krusemark will serve as piano accompanist.
