Team Up for Spring Aquatics Classes**

Classes will be offered during the evening or during the daytime. Classes meet two days per week, 30-45 minutes per session, for a total of five weeks. Enrollment is limited to six participants per class. Classes cost \$35 per course. All classes will be held at USM'S heated indoor pool in Berchmans Hall on the main campus at 4100 S. 4th St. in Leavenworth, Kan.

Evening classes for Level 1 participants will be offered from April 3 to May 3, Mondays and Wednesdays starting at 6:15 p.m. Level 2 courses will start April 3 to May 3, and will be offered on Mondays and Wednesdays starting at 6:45 p.m. Level 3, 4, and 5 classes will begin April 3 to May 3, offered Mondays and Wednesdays starting at 7:25 p.m. Daytime classes will also be offered for Levels 1, 2 and 3.
