University of Saint Mary Inducts Two Graduates Into Athletic Hall of Fame

(Leavenworth, Kan.)— The University of Saint Mary recently inducted two graduates into its Athletic Hall of Fame. Katie Greene, a 2001 graduate and former Saint Mary volleyball player, and George “Taber” Medill, a 2002 graduate and former Saint Mary soccer player were inducted on Saturday, Feb. 2, at a ceremony in the Ryan Sports Center between the Spires women’s and men’s basketball games.

Greene, who majored in chemistry at Saint Mary, is a Shawnee, Kan. native now living in San Francisco. She is the information technology editor for *Technology Review*, a magazine and website published by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. She continues to play volleyball every Monday night in a co-ed league.

Greene started and played in nearly every volleyball game during her four years at Saint Mary. She was nominated Conference Player of the Week numerous times, won a handful of All-Tournament Team honors, and was named First Team All-MCAC in 1997, 1998, 1999, First Team All KCAC in 2000, NAIA scholar Athlete in 1999, and Saint Mary College Female Scholar Athlete of the Year in 2000.

Medill, an accounting and business administration graduate, lives in Lansing, Kan. He is now an internal review officer in the business office at Fort Leavenworth.

Medill played soccer for two years at Saint Mary. He led the team to KCAC championships in 2000 and 2001, was First Team All KCAC in 2000 and 2001, KCAC Offensive Player of the Year in 2001, First Team NAIA All-Region in 2000 and 2001, and NAIA All-American Honorable Mention in 2000 and 2001.

The Hall of Fame is located inside Ryan Sports Center on the main campus in Leavenworth. Saint Mary has eight varsity sports: football, volleyball, baseball, softball, men’s and women’s basketball, and men’s and women’s soccer.
