The Goldenbergs have impeccable resumes in the music world, and have made it a tradition to come to USM for free recitals. Susan Goldenberg has played in the first violin section of the Kansas City Symphony for the past 30 years. William Goldenberg is distinguished professor of music at Northern Illinois University, where he also serves as director of the collaborative piano program.

The Goldenberg Duo has performed in China, Sweden, Denmark, Canada, Great Britain, and throughout the U.S.
