University of Saint Mary Instrumental Ensembles Present "An Evening of Chamber Music" *7 p.m. Tuesday, March 30, Annunciation Chapel*

(Leavenworth, Kan.)—The University of Saint Mary instrumental ensembles will present "*An Evening of Chamber Music*," a Baroque and Classical music concert at 7 p.m. Tues., March 30, in Annunciation Chapel on USM's Leavenworth Campus, 4100 South 4th Street.

The concert is free and open to the public.

Several ensembles of student performers—all under the direction of Freda Proctor, USM assistant professor of music—will play at the event.

String ensembles will perform a violin trio, a Mozart church sonata, and movements of two Vivaldi concerti.

Both the mixed woodwind ensemble and clarinet choir will present Haydn compositions, and the flute choir will play an arrangement of Bach's "*Air*" from the "*Suite in D*."

And brass ensemble selections will include Pachelbel's "*Magnificat Primi Toni*" and three short works by Pezel. The horn section will also present a work by Poole, and a Telemann Fantasia will be performed as a trumpet and trombone duet.
