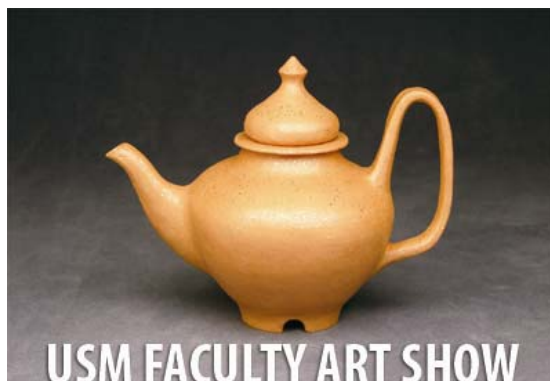


University of Saint Mary Art Professors Display Their Artistry at USM Faculty Art Show

Opening Reception Set for 3 p.m. Friday, Sept. 17, in Goppert Gallery

(Leavenworth, Kan.)—The University of Saint Mary presents the USM Faculty Art Show Friday, Sept. 17, through Oct. 8 in USM's Goppert Gallery in Xavier Hall on the Main Campus in Leavenworth, 4100 South 4th Street. The opening reception for the show will be 3-5 p.m. Sept. 17 in Goppert Gallery.

The gallery's regular hours are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. Admission is free.



The show features the work of Associate Art Professor Susan Nelson, who heads up USM's art program, and Associate Art Professor Alexandra Robinson.

Nelson's portion of the exhibit will include her newest ceramic works—particularly teapots, tea cups, and unusual flower arranging vessels—crafted out of New Mexico micaceous clay. Robinson will be exhibiting an installation work and some drawings that grew out of her experiences during an artist residency she completed earlier this year at Jentel in Wyoming.

“This show will give viewers an opportunity to see the range of talent within USM's art faculty, from fine craft to the exploration of contemporary media and expression,” said Dr. William Krusemark, chair of the USM department of fine arts.
