### University of Saint Mary Instrumental Ensembles to Entertain with 'An Evening of Chamber Music'

(Leavenworth, Kan.)—The University of Saint Mary instrumental ensembles will present An Evening of Chamber Music, a Baroque and Classical music concert at 7 p.m. Tues., April 5, in Annunciation Chapel on USM's Leavenworth Campus, 4100 South 4<sup>th</sup> Street.

The concert is free and open to the public.

Several ensembles of student and community performers—all under the direction of Freda Proctor, USM assistant professor of music—will play at the event.

String ensembles will perform Pachelbel's *Canon in D*, a Mozart Fantasia, and Saint-Saën's *The Swan*.

Woodwind performances will include two flute duets, a flute and clarinet duet, a clarinet ensemble, and a double flute trio. A flute choir will play an arrangement of Albinoni's *Adagio*.

Lastly, brass ensemble selections will include Buxtehude's *Fanfare and Chorus* and two 16<sup>th</sup> century motets by Vittoria and Aitchinger. The horn section will play a quartet by Reed.
