- Current** USM student (in the evening accelerated program at Overland Park or at the Kansas City, Kansas location in Providence Medical Center) refers a “new”* degree seeking student to the evening program at OPC or KCK via the online refer a student form at www.stmary.edu/refer.
- Within 6 months of application, “new”* student must be enrolled and classes confirmed.
- Current** student will be eligible for a USM padfolio or a sweatshirt from the USM Spirit Shop (not to exceed a retail value of \$35).
- Current** student will receive the padfolio or USM sweatshirt after the 3rd week of the first 8-week term in which both students are enrolled and in attendance in a Overland Park or KCK evening class.

Rules and Regulations
2011/2012 Overland Park Accelerated Undergrad or Grad Student
New Student Referral Rewards Program

The following describes the rules and regulations for earning an award for the referral of a new degree seeking student (2011/2012 academic year). Current** students must qualify to win by satisfying the terms, requirements, and conditions set forth below:

1. This referral reward program is void where prohibited by law.
2. This program is subject to all federal, state, and local laws.
3. Students must be at least 18 years to earn an award.
4. Each prospective student registration is valid for six months from date of application.
5. Members of the staff and faculty of University of Saint Mary and their family members are not eligible to win.
6. The award is not transferable. It must be used by the person earning the award.
7. The referred student must pay tuition and all fees applicable to the first course (or courses) so registered\through the third week of class.

8. Each award winner assumes sole responsibility for all federal, state and/or other tax liabilities and any other requirements associated with the award.
9. Students participating in this award program grant to University of Saint Mary the right to use their name as the referring person in any dealings Saint Mary may have with the person referred.
10. University of Saint Mary reserves the right to amend the terms, requirements, and conditions of the award program at any time and to terminate the program at any time without prior notice.

* “New” student - defined as a first time applicant to University of Saint Mary.

** Current student - a student that is either enrolled for the most recent term (evening classes) or will be enrolled as a returning student during the first term of enrollment (evening classes) for the “new” student.
